User Manual


System requirements

- Windows XP SP2
- .NET Framework 3.5 SP1
- RAM: 1GB
- Screen resolution: 1024 x 768 or higher
- Processor Intel Core Duo 1.0 GHz
- 100 MB free disk space
- Microsoft Outlook 2003 for Outlook integration feature
- Adobe Reader 9 for reading of User Manual

Functionalities

Calendar

Move mouse over bright panel on the bottom of the screen  or click application icon in system clock area  to show calendar. Click pin  to make calendar stay visible. When calendar is hidden and “Enable calendar top most” property is set (Properties window) calendar will cover other applications. You can also click application icon in system clock area  to show calendar.



The calendar can be navigated with  buttons. Arrows move back and forward, the dot sign goes back to current date. An alternative way of navigation is clicking month name at header of the central calendar. Then month can be chosen. Again, header (year) can be clicked to choose a year.

If you use windows taskbar auto-hide functionality, it is recommended to have calendar pinned.


Clock

Each of clocks can be set to different time zone. Central clock is always set to your local time zone. You can change the description of this clock by clicking it. Time zone of side clocks can be changed – click a face or description. You can change clocks layout between vertical and horizontal layout – see Preferences. If you do not want to use clocks, mark off “Show clock” in Properties window.

Ship image

Each month of the year has the ship’s image assigned. The image is displayed as wallpaper. You can change the ship being displayed by "Change vessel" option from application icon in system clock area  or button  on the right top of the calendar pane.

Properties

Click an application icon in system clock area with right mouse button  and click Properties to adjust personal settings.

If you want to have your calendar visible on the locked screen, then set “Show items while desktop is locked” property.

If you want to use clocks use “Show clocks” property.


To choose clocks layout between horizontal and vertical use “Clocks layout”.
To let the calendar cover other applications set “Enable calendar top most”.
If you want calendar to integrate with Microsoft Outlook use “Enable Microsoft Outlook integration”

Outlook integration

Application is able to integrate with Microsoft Outlook Calendar. This functionality can be switched off any time. Days marked in the calendar with bold contain some events in Outlook Calendar. When you hold a cursor above a given day, a balloon containing more information, appears.

Above functionality works only when Microsoft Outlook is running.
Double click on a day opens Microsoft Outlook at the day.

Remarks

If you experience some rendering problem, please click application icon in system clock area with right mouse button  and use Refresh function.

Known issues and solutions

	Issue	Solution
1.	When changing clocks layout between horizontal and vertical, clocks disappear.	Click application icon (in system notification area) with right mouse button, and choose Refresh from context menu.
2.	In some cases application can try to synchronize events after Outlook was closed. Then Outlook icon can blink.	Close Outlook process in Windows processes window.
3.	As calendar panel is defined as top most window, it can happen that, it show above screensaver.	An user can do not allow calendar be top most window by uncheck "Enable calendar top most" in Properties (right click calendar icon in system clock area).
